Chronic Disease Management Programme V3.1

Note: Requires Health One Version 9.0.1.3069 or later. In line with the HSE the following amendments have been made to the CDM programme.

- **GMS Patients**
 - The Prevention Programme is open to GMS patients **over 18** if they have
 - Gestational Diabetes or Pre-eclampsia diagnosed since Jan 2023.
 - Hypertension.
- **Private Patients**
 - The Prevention Programme is open to all Private patients over 18 **if** they have Gestational Diabetes or Pre-eclampsia diagnosed since Jan 2023.
 - Patient can be moved to the CDM programme if they have a PP review with an Outcome of 'Register on CDM Programme' for Diabetes.

Opportunistic Case Findings

- Registration Form: Hypertension (HTN) has been removed as the patient has direct access to the Prevention Programme if they have Hypertension.
- The Outcome reasons have been updated for 'Register on Prevention Programme' in line with the Prevention Programme Registration reasons.


Prevention Programme

Registration Form updated to include additional reasons:

- Hypertension Stage 1 (BP140/90 to 155/99mmHg) with NO target organ damage.
- Gestational Diabetes (if diagnosed since 1st Jan 2023)
- Pre-eclampsia (if diagnosed since 1st Jan 2023)

CDM


- Two new mandatory questions have been added for all CDM Diseases.



Investigations

- ⊖ How many ED attendances (not admitted) related to their chronic disease(s) has the patient had in the last 6 months?
- ⊖ How many unscheduled admissions related to their chronic disease(s) has the patient had in the last 6 months?

- One new mandatory question has been added if the patient has COPD / Asthma.



⊖ How many exacerbations (i.e. requiring treatment with Antibiotics and/or Steroids) has the patient had in the last 6 months?
